For the first time in history the Anne Frank House presents a pioneering experience outside of Amsterdam, to immerse visitors in a full-scale recreation of the Annex, where Anne Frank, her parents and sister, and four other Jewish inhabitants spent two years hiding to evade Nazi capture. This exhibit will give you the chance to learn about Anne Frank, not as a victim but through the multifaceted lens of her life - as a girl, a writer, and a symbol of resilience and strength. View more than 100 original collection items from the Anne Frank House in Amsterdam, including several never-before-exhibited artifacts.

The exhibit helps to convey the context that shaped Anne's life, death, and posthumous fame. Her diary is one of the most translated books in the world, and this is a powerful experience that will resonate with you long after this visit. Next we head to Katz's Deli for a delightful lunch, and then the Museum of Jewish Heritage, a living memorial to the Holocaust.
